# What is the Gender at the Centre Initiative (GCI)?

- A multistakeholder initiative to promote gender equality in and through education
- Launched in 2019 by G7 Ministers of education and development
- GCI Alliance: partnership between Ministries of Education, civil society, donors, multilateral agencies
- Implemented in 8 countries: Mali, Mauritania, Niger,
  Chad, Burkina Faso, Sierra Leone, Mozambique, Nigeria
- Coordinated by UNGEI and UNESCO-IIEP



# Gender-Responsive Education Sector Planning (GRESP)

GCI is rooted in Gender-Responsive Education Sector Planning (GRESP):

- Whole-system approach to embed gender equality in the DNA of national education systems
- Guidance, tools and capacity building to support governments with gender analysis, gender-sensitive stakeholder consultation, developing gender-responsive education strategies, budgeting and monitoring
- Analyzing and addressing unequal gender norms are one of the key elements of GRESP



# Transforming gender norms through GCI

### A. Within communities:

- Research on social norms in 8 GCI countries
- CSO consortium works with young feminist activists and community leaders to catalyze a dialogue on gender norms and promoting more equal chances to education

### B. Within governments:

- Research on gender norms and institutional cultures within governments
- Course on Transformative Leadership
- Promoting cross-sectoral collaboration to address issues that are embedded in unequal gender norms (child marriage, SRGBV, adolescent pregnancy...)
